About the FITTskills Program

FITT adds insight, effectiveness and prestige to international business programs, as well as real, practical value for your graduates. FITT offers **FITTskills** directly to industry and through educational institutions to bring industry-based perspectives to the content.

The **FITTskills** Program is a full suite of eight multi-disciplinary training courses that build trade readiness for today's complex, integrated world of commerce. **FITTskills** courses can be delivered as a series, individually or incorporated into an existing business program of study. These courses are:

- Global Business Environment
- International Marketing
- International Trade Finance
- Global Supply Chain Management
- International Market Entry Strategies
- International Trade Research
- Legal Aspects of International Trade
- International Trade Management

Together, these courses and the corresponding assessments meet educational requirements and provide your students with advanced standing toward the CITP designation.²

When educational institutions incorporate **FITTskills** into an existing business program of study, their students can gain access to dual credentials—recognition of their academic achievement from your institution along with trade certification from FITT, which is a nationally-and internationally-recognized credential based on a portable set of practical skills.

FITT Credentials

FITT's credentials include three levels of recognition and qualifications: FITT Certificate; FITT Diploma; and the FITT **Certified International Trade Professional (CITP)** designation. Each is achieved based on the following criteria:

FITT Certificate in International Trade

Presented to individuals who've successfully completed any four **FITTskills** courses (or equivalency thereof).

FITT Diploma in International Trade

Presented to individuals who've successfully completed all eight **FITTskills** courses (or equivalency thereof).

CITP Designation

All **CITP** candidates must apply directly to FITT to ensure they meet the required criteria to achieve the CITP professional designation. Applicants must have earned their **FITT** Diploma, have achieved their practical work experience requirement (at least one full year), have endorsed the **CITP** Standards of Ethical Conduct, have committed to ongoing professional development in the discipline of international business, and have paid their annual **CITP** dues.

The **CITP** holder has demonstrated they have achieved the core competencies relevant to international business through skills and knowledge acquisition and industry experience. The **CITP** designation promotes the advancement of international business professionals working in a wide variety of roles and organisations by recognizing their high levels of skill and experience within international trade.

Credential Assessments

Each of the eight **FITTskills** courses has an accompanying assessment. The assessments are available in multiple-choice format and are taken online. FITT accepts projects in lieu of the multiple-choice exam for three of the eight courses: International Trade Research, International Marketing, and International Trade Management.

- The CITP designation is a highly desirable industry credential that adds extra credibility to academic recognition.
- The CITP designation is held by hundreds of Canadians doing business around the world.

2) Platinum Accredited Partner:

Your International Business Program can be FITT-accredited *WITH* the built-in delivery of FITT Certificates and Diplomas. This partnership is best applied within organisations that have an international business program and want their students to have a direct link to FITT and FITT's credentials. FITT will accredit **your** international business program and provide a seamless process to move your students through to the formalized recognition of their **FITT Certificate** and **FITT Diploma**. This is the most direct route to the formalized FITT recognition for your students. Details *pp.*10 - 11.

3) Accredited Partner:

Your International Business Program can be FITT-accredited *WITHOUT* the built-in delivery of FITT Certificates and Diplomas. This partnership is best applied to organisations seeking FITT recognition for their international business programs. FITT will accredit **your** international business program then we will leave it up to your students to self-manage the process to receive their FITT credentials. Details *p*.12.

FITTskills Delivery Partner

What's involved: The FITTskills program is delivered in the classroom by you using FITT materials and assessments. Your institution would be responsible for facilities, hiring of instructors, and administering the FITTskills assessments. You set the tuition rate and all teaching support materials, and other learning resources will be provided to you by FITT within the all-inclusive, per participant price.

Benefits:

- You will receive a proven and ready-to-teach FITT-developed curriculum as well as exams/project assessments within a turnkey training program.
- FITT will provide program administration support as well as the curriculum, reducing resource requirements at **your institution**.
- Your students will receive 2-for-1 educational credentials and advanced standing toward the CITP designation.

Our experience is that students are more likely to complete the process to receive their FITT Certificates and Diplomas when the process is managed for them.

Institutional Recognition:

Your international business program will be recognized as a business program that meets the FITT nationally-and globally-recognized **CITP** designation competencies.

Student Recognition:

- Upon successful completion of the FITT-accredited program and required FITT
 assessment(s), s/he will earn the FITT Diploma. The FITT Certificate is available upon
 request.
- A 2-for-1 educational credential enhances students' resumés and attests to the fact that they possess the skills and knowledge of an industry-recognized program.
- Students holding a **FITT Diploma** will gain advanced standing toward the **CITP** designation, having completed the academic requirement in full.

What's involved: Your institution's international business program will be recognized by FITT as meeting *all* of the CITP competencies. To obtain FITT credentials, students will be required to contact FITT directly for additional assessments, transfer of their credits and to receive their FITT Certificates and Diplomas.

Recognition:

- Your institution will benefit from recognition that your business program meets all of the CITP competencies.
- Your business program will gain prestige and have enhanced value as a result of your
 affiliation with industry and the world's highly respected international trade credentials
 from FITT.

Student Recognition:

2-for-1 educational credentials can be obtained by students to enhance their resumés. This will attest to the fact that they meet the skills and knowledge requirements of an industry-recognized program. But in this option, students do not graduate with the same level of advanced standing toward the **CITP** professional designation as those described in the Platinum Accredited Partner option.

Other Benefits:

Program coordinators will receive promotional and administrative support from FITT.

Cost:

The cost associated with completing the **CITP** educational requirements will be \$575.00 for each student upon graduation from your FITT-accredited program. This fee to the participant

includes access to all 8 **FITTskills** e-Books, transfer of their credits to FITT, and access to write one Professional Examination <u>OR</u> two of the FITTskills assessments (two online exams <u>or</u> two project assessments).
